### Supplier Consignment Inventory

*MFG/PRO eB2 manages consigned inventory from the point of view of both the company shipping consigned goods to a customer and the company receiving consigned goods from a supplier. The Consignment Inventory module provides this functionality as an additional capability to MFG/PRO.*

*Suppliers and customers in close trading partner relationships need integrated information to ensure that adequate inventories exist to fulfill current orders and projected requirements in a timely manner. This information is also needed to make efficient use of storage facilities and plant capacity.*

### Customer Consignment Inventory

Customer Consignment Inventory extends the sales order process by providing new transactions to ship material and identify it as in-transit or consigned. It enables the user to plan, order, ship, track and report, customer-consigned material, while deferring invoicing and accounts receivable (AR) transactions. Once the customer notifies the supplier of usage, standard invoice transactions occur. Customer Consignment Inventory also enables suppliers to continue to track inventory after the materials ship and reside at the customer's facility. As a result, Consignment Inventory alleviates the need for suppliers to buy back excess material sent to the customer at the end of the consigned period.



The maintenance menu enables you to define specific default values for combinations of ship to addresses and item numbers.

## FEATURES

- Create consigned inventory, inventory off-set and in-transit accounts at system level for product lines or combinations of sites and product lines
- Retain ownership of consigned inventory by deferring financial transactions until inventory is consumed
- Track consigned inventory automatically by defining inventory locations for items that are in transit and items received by a customer
- Maintain visibility of consigned inventory for physical and cycle counts
- Set up consigned defaults at the system level for the majority of sales orders and scheduled orders and tailor defaults for individual ship to addresses and items
- Separate shipping and billing functions to accurately determine inventory value
- Create and ship sales or scheduled orders that include both non-consigned and consigned items
- Determine the tax point for consigned inventory based on settings in the associated tax rate. The tax point can be at receipt, at vouchering or at consumption
- Compare material shipped/received with material consumed
- Identify unconsumed material that exceeds its maximum aging date





*With Supplier Consignment, you have the ability to modify specific combinations of suppliers and items.*

### Supplier Consignment Inventory

Supplier Consignment Inventory extends the purchase order process by providing new transactions to receive material and identify it as consigned. It supports the user in the same manner as Customer Consignment Inventory but from the point of view of the receiving company. A company using consigned inventory pays for only what it uses, not for what it receives. EDI transmissions can be used to inform suppliers of item usage, or records can be sent manually.

With Supplier Consignment Inventory, you can delay the financial transaction on consignment inventory until it is consumed, but the material is still visible for planning. When consumption is reported back to the supplier, the supplier can transfer liability for the material in its system and issue an invoice if self-billing is not being used.
